

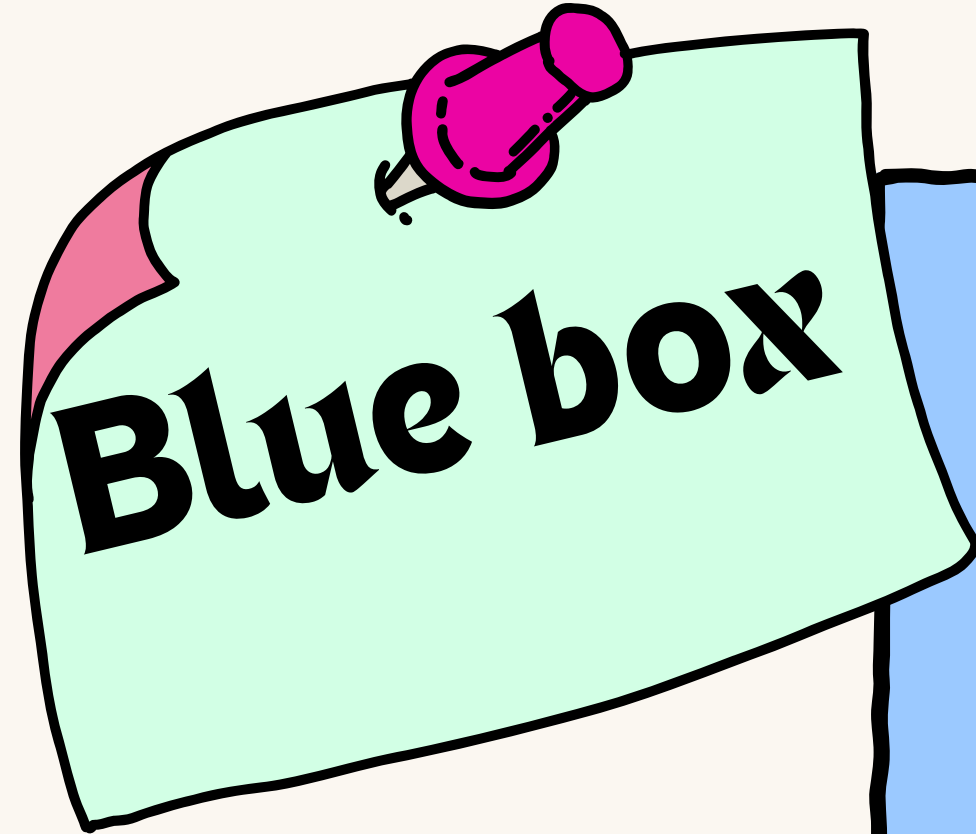

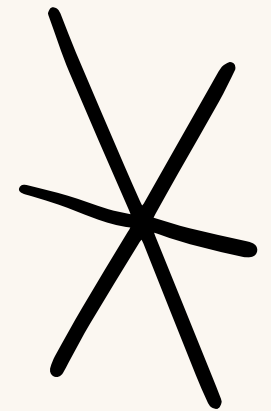

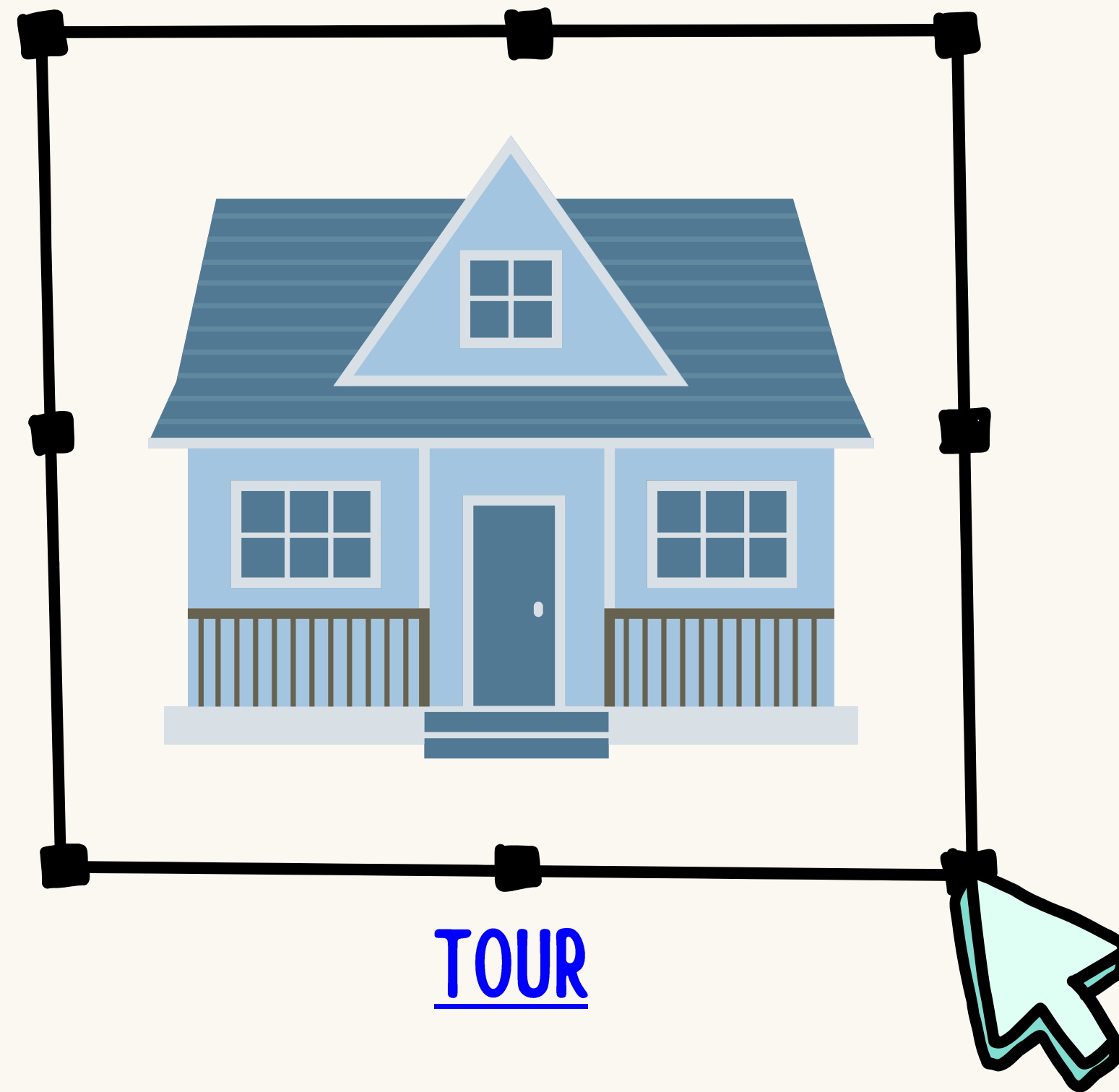


BLUE BOX

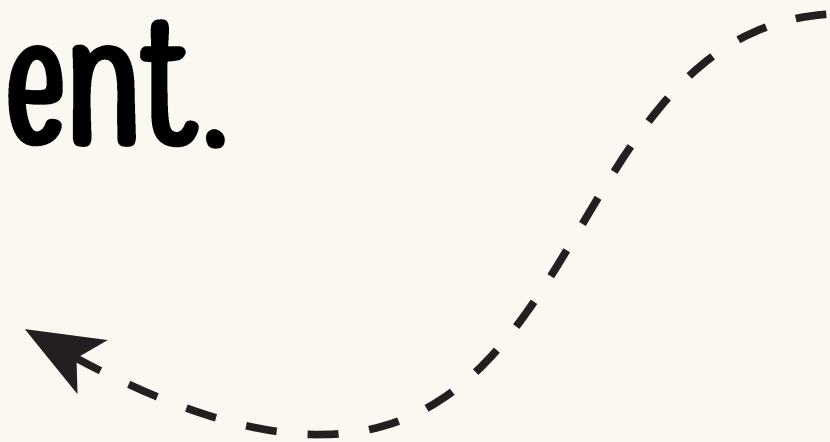


**is an intensively supervised transitional residential home for female and young adults with a mental illness and/or severe psychosocial problems.**





The blue.box youth residence consists of a shared living space with eight single rooms and a small apartment.



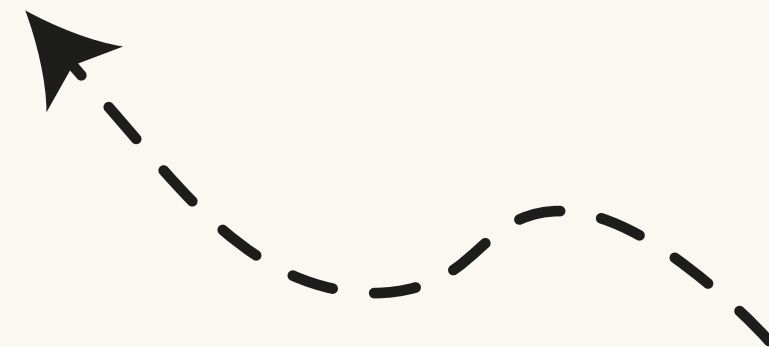
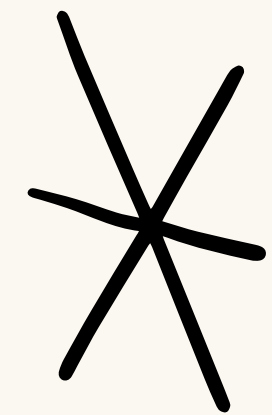

## INTERVIEW

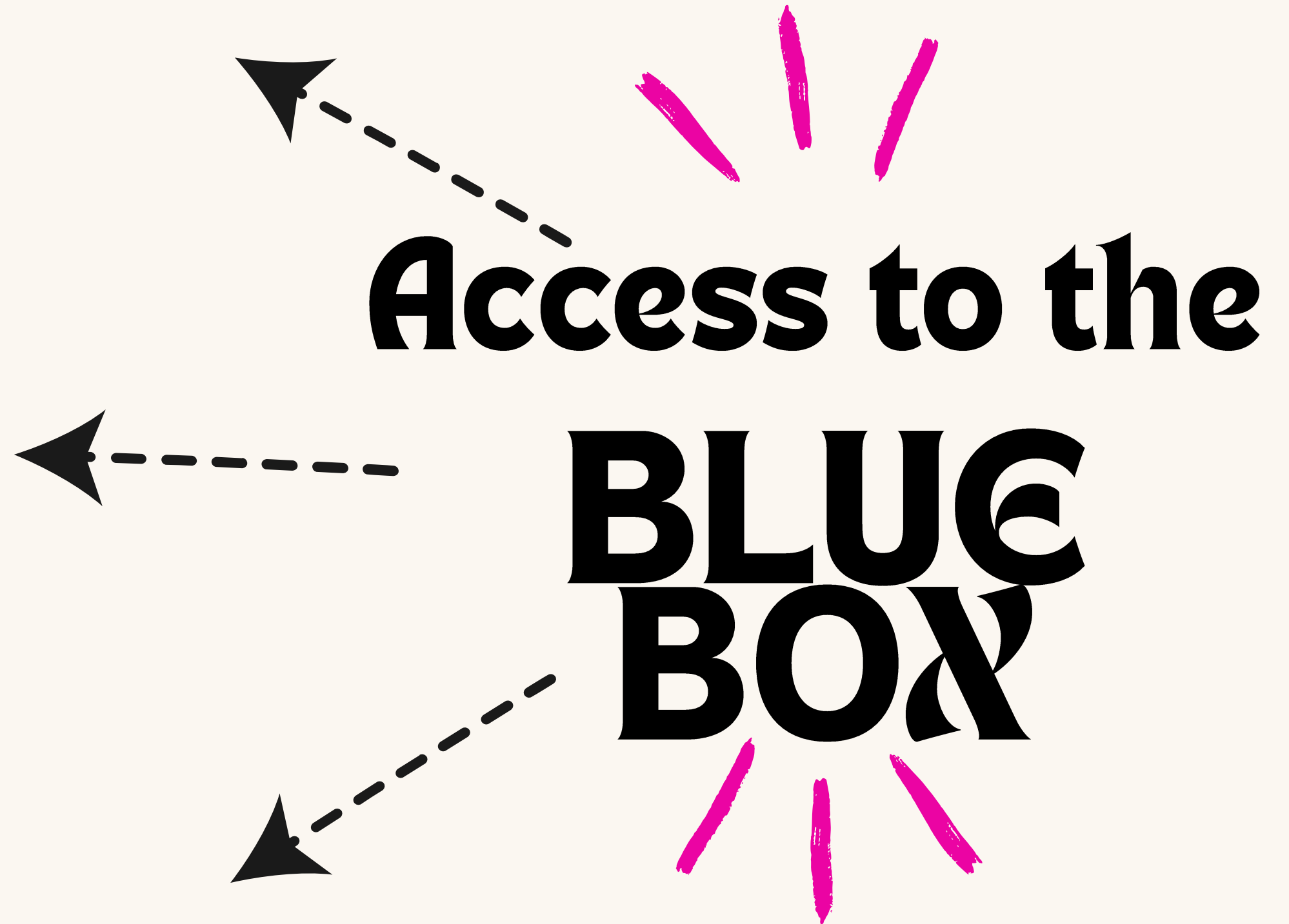
- After clarifying the admission criteria, They invite the young people/young adults, relatives, and/or key people or those involved in the support system to an initial interview at the youth residence.

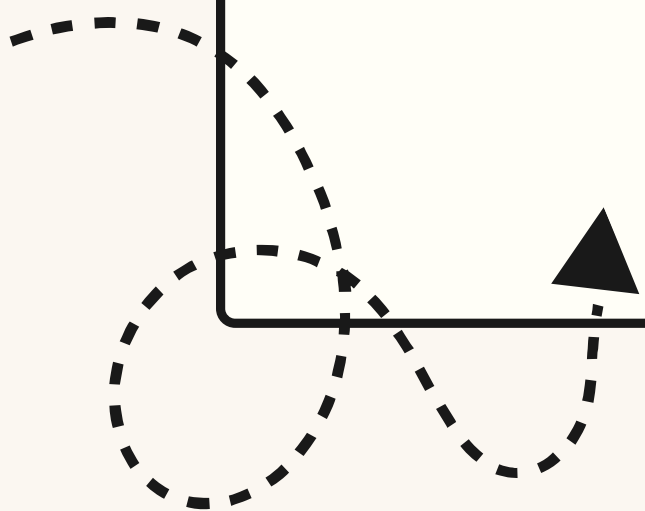

specialized social workers, or similar.**

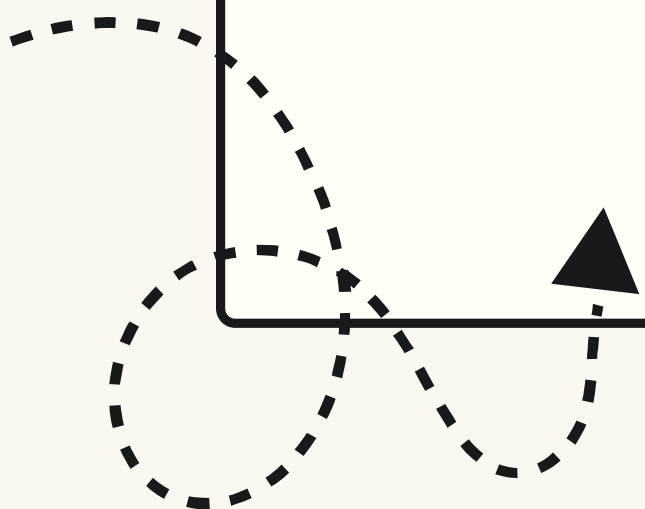




## **FUNDING**

Funding is provided by the Social Services Department of the State of Upper Austria.

Residents are charged a monthly fee of €157.69 and a one-time deposit of €150.



# FREE TIME



- DIVIDES THE HOUSEWORK EACH WEEK
- GIRLS CAN SPEND THEIR FREE TIME HOWEVER THEY WANT
- FIELD TRIPS ARE ORGANIZED, BUT PARTICIPATION IS NOT REQUIRED
- THE GIRLS PLAN THE WEEKLY FOOD MENU THEMSELVES
- GIRLS CAN INVITE GUESTS, BUT THEY CAN'T STAY OVERNIGHT.
