

Building the Future: integrating Culture, Education, and Empowerment for Sustainability Event Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all individuals attending the GWI 2025 General Assembly, Conference, and related events, to be held in Zambia in September 2025. This includes delegates, accompanying persons, students, media representatives, speakers, and exhibitors (collectively referred to as "delegates" or "participants").

FEES

All fees are General Assembly and Conference fees are inclusive of lunch, refreshments, conference documentation and attendance and the Cultural Celebration Dinner. All other events are separate fees. Participants should retain a copy (digital or physical) of their payment confirmation to present at the registration desk if requested.

GWI has taken all reasonable care in making arrangements for the 2025 General Assembly, Conference, and events. In the occurrence of any unforeseen disruptions, GWI cannot be held responsible for any losses incurred by participants. The programme is correct at the time of printing, but organisers reserve the right to revise the programme if and when deemed necessary.

VAT

Where applicable, fees may be subject to VAT in accordance with the laws of Zambia. Participants are responsible for checking their local tax obligations.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations received before 10 August 2025 will be eligible for a 50% refund of the registration fee. No refunds will be provided for cancellations received after this date. Substitutions are permitted at any time, subject to a 10% administrative fee. No refunds will be issued for no-shows. Refunds, where applicable, will be processed after the event. Early-bird rates apply only to participants who register and complete payment by the published deadline. Registrants who fail to pay by the deadline will be charged the standard fee. Registration is not confirmed until payment is received; unconfirmed participants will not be listed in the official programme or participants list.

The early-bird registration fee will only be applicable to participants who register and pay prior to the early-bird cut-off dates mentioned. A participant who registers prior to the cut-off date and omits to pay, will automatically be charged the higher registration fee without prior notification.

Until payment has been received, registration for the General Assembly, Conference, and any of its associated events cannot be confirmed and without confirmed registration, participants will not be listed in the programme or in the list of participants.

VISA AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

t is the participant's responsibility to ensure compliance with all visa, health, and vaccination requirements necessary for entry into Zambia. GWI accepts no responsibility for participants who are denied entry due to incomplete documentation or non-compliance.

FORCE MAJEURE

Force majeure refers to circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the organisers, including but not limited to war, civil unrest, strikes, natural disasters, and suspension of transportation services. In such cases, both parties are released from their contractual obligations without liability.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

All participants are strongly advised to obtain comprehensive travel and health insurance to cover any contingencies, including trip cancellation, medical emergencies, or loss of personal belongings.

Third Party Terms and Conditions

All third-party services (e.g., hotels, tours, and transport) are governed by the terms and conditions of the respective service providers. GWI assumes no responsibility for the performance of such services. Any disputes arising from these services are subject to Zambian law and jurisdiction. The Conference Secretariat reserves the right to make changes as and when deemed necessary, without prior notice to the parties concerned. All disputes are subject to resolution under Zambia law.

All accommodation, conference and other arrangements are subject to alteration and cancellation at any time without prior notice, due to factors that are outside of the organisers' reasonable control. This will be at the sole and absolute discretion of the organisers. Should such events, such as Force Majeure, render the organisers unable to deliver such service, the organisers shall not be held responsible. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any damages, and/or costs, whatsoever arising from any such alteration or cancellation.
