Pauluskerk

- The Pauluskerk (St. Paul's Church) in Rotterdam is a diaconal center and a meeting place for vulnerable residents of Rotterdam, including the homeless and undocumented people

Barka Foundation

- Barka is an organization that supports and guides vulnerable EU citizens, mainly homeless labor migrants from Central and Eastern Europe, in the Netherlands. The foundation's goal is to help these individuals get their lives back on track, either by building a dignified existence in the Netherlands or by returning to their home country



Belvédère

Verhalenhuis (story house)
Belvédère is a cultural meeting place located in a monumental building from 1894 in Katendrecht, Rotterdam. The house tells the stories of the city and its residents through changing exhibitions, workshops, and events

Mixblik

- Mixblik is a social enterprise (a learning–working company) from Rotterdam that produces organic, vegetarian meals in cans, prepared by women who have recently arrived in the Netherlands.

ROS Foundation

- The ROS foundation advocates for the interests of undocumented migrants in Rotterdam, such as migrants without a residence permit, rejected asylum seekers, and stateless persons



Mano foundation

- Mano foundation is an organization committed to an inclusive society, with a focus on vulnerable individuals and families in Rotterdam. Among other things, it is involved with the refugee boat *the Silja*.

Museum Fenix

- Museum FENIX is an art museum in Rotterdam focused on the theme of migration, located in a restored harbor warehouse in Katendrecht



Important
