Main topic: Events as the Engine: Mastering Event-Led Growth (ELG) for Pipeline & Revenue

A six-step process was shared for implementing event-led growth, including aligning events with corporate goals, creating continuous content, collecting and analysing data, training staff, measuring success, and continuously improving event strategies.

- It is increasingly important to view events as strategic tools rather than tactical activities – we discussed challenges such as being perceived as tactical rather than strategic partners
- Events should be strategic engines to drive customers through the entire process for organisations
- Events should be continuous rather than one-off marketing activities, combining content, community, and data
- It is important to offer unique experiences to attract high-quality leads, as people, including wealthy individuals, value experiences over products
- There is a growing trust in face-to-face interactions in an AI and deepfake world
- It is key to align events with corporate goals, creating valuable content, and leveraging data to measure success and improve outcomes
- We must evaluate event success beyond basic metrics, often we don't spend enough time analysing data to understand its strategic value
