

# Genesis Amateur Golf Tournament 2026

## Terms and Conditions

Throughout these Terms and Conditions, "Genesis" means Genesis Motor UK Ltd.

### 1. About the Tournament

Genesis is organising a series of amateur golf tournaments across four markets in 2026. Local qualifying tournaments will be held in France, Italy, Germany and the United Kingdom. Winners from each market will be invited to attend the Genesis Scottish Open as hospitality guests of Genesis from 11 to 13 July 2026.

These Terms and Conditions govern participation in the local tournament(s) organised in the United Kingdom and, where applicable, the associated hospitality at the Genesis Scottish Open.

### 2. Eligibility

To be eligible to apply, participants must satisfy all of the following conditions at the time of application and on an ongoing basis up to and including the date of the tournament:

- They must be at least 18 years of age.
- They must be a legal resident of the United Kingdom.
- They must hold a valid and officially registered handicap index (HCP) of -36.0 or below, issued by a recognised national golf federation.

Genesis reserves the right to verify eligibility at any stage and to disqualify any participant found not to meet these conditions, including after selection. In particular, Genesis may require participants to present valid government-issued photographic identification at any stage of the tournament to verify their age and identity.

Persons who are employees or contractors of Genesis or any of its affiliated entities, as well as their spouses, registered/civil partners, parents and children, are not eligible to participate.

### 3. How to Apply

Applications must be submitted via the Genesis website at [www.genesis.com/uk](http://www.genesis.com/uk) during the application window.

The application window opens on **16 March 2026** and closes on **19 April 2026**. Applications submitted after the closing date will not be considered.

The application form will ask for the following information: full name and contact details, proof of residency, official handicap index and issuing federation, and Genesis vehicle ownership details where applicable.

Genesis is not responsible for any technical issues that prevent timely submission of an application.

There is a limit of one entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted, and joint submissions are not allowed.

#### **4. Selection of Participants**

Where the number of eligible applications exceeds the available places, Genesis will select participants on the basis of the following criteria:

- Genesis vehicle ownership, verified against the information provided in the application.
- Official handicap index, with preference given to applicants whose handicap index is best suited to the smooth operation of the tournament.
- Any further objective criteria reasonably determined by Genesis in connection with the purpose of the event.

Genesis vehicle ownership is a preference factor and not an absolute condition of entry. Eligible applicants who do not own a Genesis vehicle may still be selected if places remain available after applying the above criteria.

Genesis reserves the right to decline any application without providing detailed reasons, provided that selection is conducted in accordance with applicable anti-discrimination law. Genesis's selection decisions are final.

#### **5. Notification and Confirmation**

Selected participants will be notified by email to the address provided in their application. Upon receipt of a selection notification, participants must confirm their acceptance **within five business days** by responding as instructed in the notification email.

Failure to confirm within this period will be treated as a withdrawal and the place will be offered to the next eligible candidate. Genesis is not responsible for notification emails that are undelivered, delayed or directed to a spam folder.

Genesis reserves the right to withdraw a confirmed invitation if a participant is found to no longer meet the eligibility criteria set out in Section 2 at any point prior to the tournament.

#### **6. Tournament Regulations; Code of Conduct**

Full tournament regulations, including course details, format, scoring system and any specific local rules, will be provided to confirmed participants no later than 14 days before the date of the relevant local tournament.

Tournament regulations may differ between markets. By confirming their participation, participants agree to comply with all applicable tournament regulations notified to them.

The handicap condition applies at the time of the tournament as well as at the time of application. Participants whose handicap index (HPC) exceeds -36.0 at the time of the tournament may be disqualified.

Participants are expected to behave respectfully and responsibly throughout the tournament and any associated hospitality events. This includes compliance with all applicable venue rules, course etiquette and the instructions of event staff. Conduct that is abusive, threatening,

discriminatory, dangerous or otherwise disruptive to the event or its participants may result in immediate exclusion from the tournament without compensation.

## **7. Prize and Hospitality Package**

The winner or winners of each local tournament will be invited to attend the Genesis Scottish Open as hospitality guests of Genesis from 11 to 13 July 2026. The hospitality package includes event tickets, transportation to and from the event (including round-trip business class flights inclusive of all applicable airport taxes, fees and duties, from the capital city of the country in which the winner lives), and accommodation for the duration of the visit. It does not include participation in the tournament. Flights may be indirect and will be determined by Genesis at its sole discretion. Accommodation will be selected by Genesis at its sole discretion.

The number of winners from The United Kingdom is four (4), corresponding to the number of local tournaments held in that market.

The prize is personal to the winner and is non-transferable. It has no cash alternative. Genesis reserves the right to substitute any element of the hospitality package with an equivalent alternative in the event of circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

## **8. Liability**

Genesis's liability to participants is limited to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law. Genesis is not liable for any personal injury, loss or damage suffered in connection with participation in the tournament, except where caused by its gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

Genesis is not liable for any costs incurred by participants independently, including travel or accommodation costs, in the event of a cancellation or postponement.

Genesis reserves the right to cancel, postpone or modify any local tournament or the European Final due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including severe weather, venue unavailability or force majeure. In such cases, Genesis's obligation is limited to a refund of any entry fee paid, if applicable.

Nothing in these Terms and Conditions excludes or limits any liability that cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

## **9. Data Protection**

Genesis, as data controller, will process the personal data submitted solely for the purpose of administering the tournament, including processing applications, selecting participants, notifying winners and arranging the hospitality package. Genesis intend to publicly make available the surname and county of winning participants (unless this is objected to by such a participant). Personal data will not be used for any other purpose without separate consent. ## **10. General**

These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the United Kingdom. Any disputes arising in connection with these Terms and Conditions shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

Genesis reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any material changes will be communicated to registered applicants prior to taking effect.

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

These Terms and Conditions do not affect any statutory rights participants may have under applicable law.
