# Cooperation with schools

## Student welfare clubs

In lower secondary school we have student welfare groups. Their goal is to strengthen social skills, life skills and the ability to cooperate .

## School on-call work

Every week youth workers visit lower secondary, vocational (Tredu), and upper secondary school. They talk to the kids about how they are doing and help them support their school attendance.

## Group-building activities

Every year youth services take part in the group-building days for 7th graders. The goal is to support the safe development of group dynamics.

## Events and theme weeks

Youth workers take part in the school's theme days and events. The goal is to strengthen young people's teamwork and personal development.



# Youth council

Kangasala's youth council is the voice of the teenagers. The aim is to let young people participate in important decisions and strengthen their decision making skills. The group brings forward young people's perspectives and promotes their wellbeing throughout the Kangasala area.

All young people aged 12-20 in Kangasala can participate. The youth council can include up to 20 regular members and 10 deputies.

# Camps, trips and events

- Youth services organise day- and overnight camps for children and teens during school holidays. The point of the camps is to offer meaningful and inspiring activities and to support families during school holidays. The camps emphasize a safe atmosphere. They focus on doing things together and provide the opportunity to try new experiences.
- Events are organised at youth centers and in cooperation with different city partners.
- Trips are organised during school holidays.



# Special Youth Work

Youth Services are cooperating with Kangasala's parish. A special youth worker provides young people with personal support and participates in activities, mobile youth work, camps and cooperation networks.

The aim of the work is to support young people's wellbeing, everyday functioning and participation.

## Regional and network cooperation

Kangasala is the part of the Pirkanmaa municipal youth work network, coordinated by the Marttinen Youth Centre.

Kangasala participates in the Tampere Region youth work project, which has produced a regional basic plan for youth work.

Youth services take part in multi-professional working groups at city and regional levels, strengthening cooperation and developing services for young people.



## Other activities

Our youth work is recorded and documented using the NuoDo system. It is used to demonstrate the volume and quality of the activities and supports knowledge-based management.

Every year youth services allocate financial resources to youth organisations to support diverse administrative activities.
