What is MiEnviro Portal?

- *MiEnviro Portal is one of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy's (EGLE) online systems for accessing environmental information, permits, and regulatory data. It allows users to view environmental records, submit comments and complaints, and search for public notices in one location.*

Where does data in MiEnviro come from?

Information provided by EGLE

- Inspection reports
- Issued permits
- Site reviews
- Reviews of submitted information
- Licenses

Information provided by non-EGLE users

- Permit applications
- Test reports
- Compliance reports
- Asbestos notifications

What else can you use MiEnviro to do?

- You can also use MiEnviro to search for:
 - Information about Michigan's beaches using BeachGuard
 - Site Map Explorer
 - Asbestos notifications
 - Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO), Retention Treatment Basin (RTB), and Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) discharge events
 - Air toxics screening levels

What do I need a MiEnviro account to access?

An account is *not* needed to

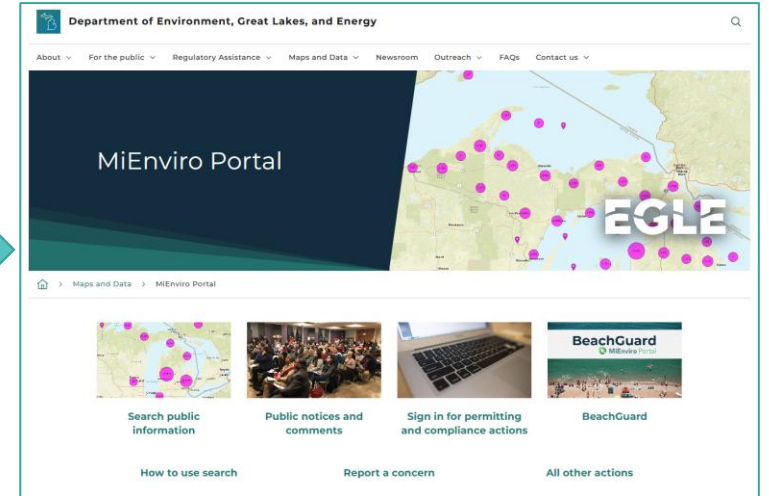
- Search for and comment on public notices and hearings
- Report spills, pollution, or other unauthorized activity
- Check BeachGuard for closures and advisories
- Submit general water and air-related complaints
- Search for and access publicly available information
- Find out if your neighbor has a permit
- Search Combined Sewer Overflow/Separate Sewer Overflow (CSO/SSO) discharges

An account *is* needed to

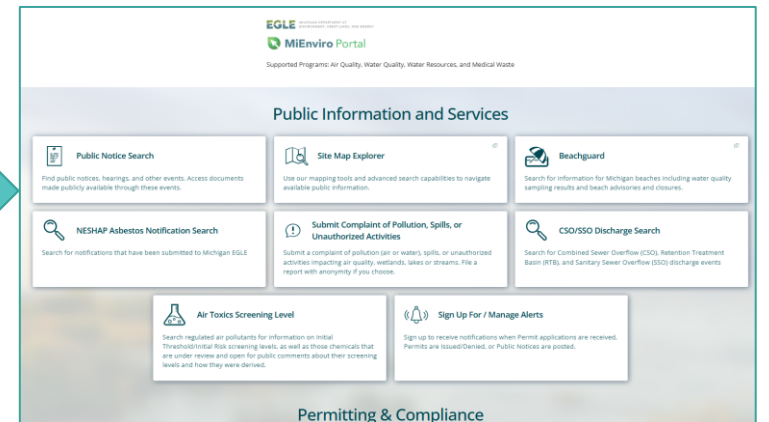
- Apply for permits and new registrations, and renew existing registrations
- Manage permits and pay permit fees
- Submit reports or management plans (required by permit or certification)
- Review evaluation/site inspections and submit service requests

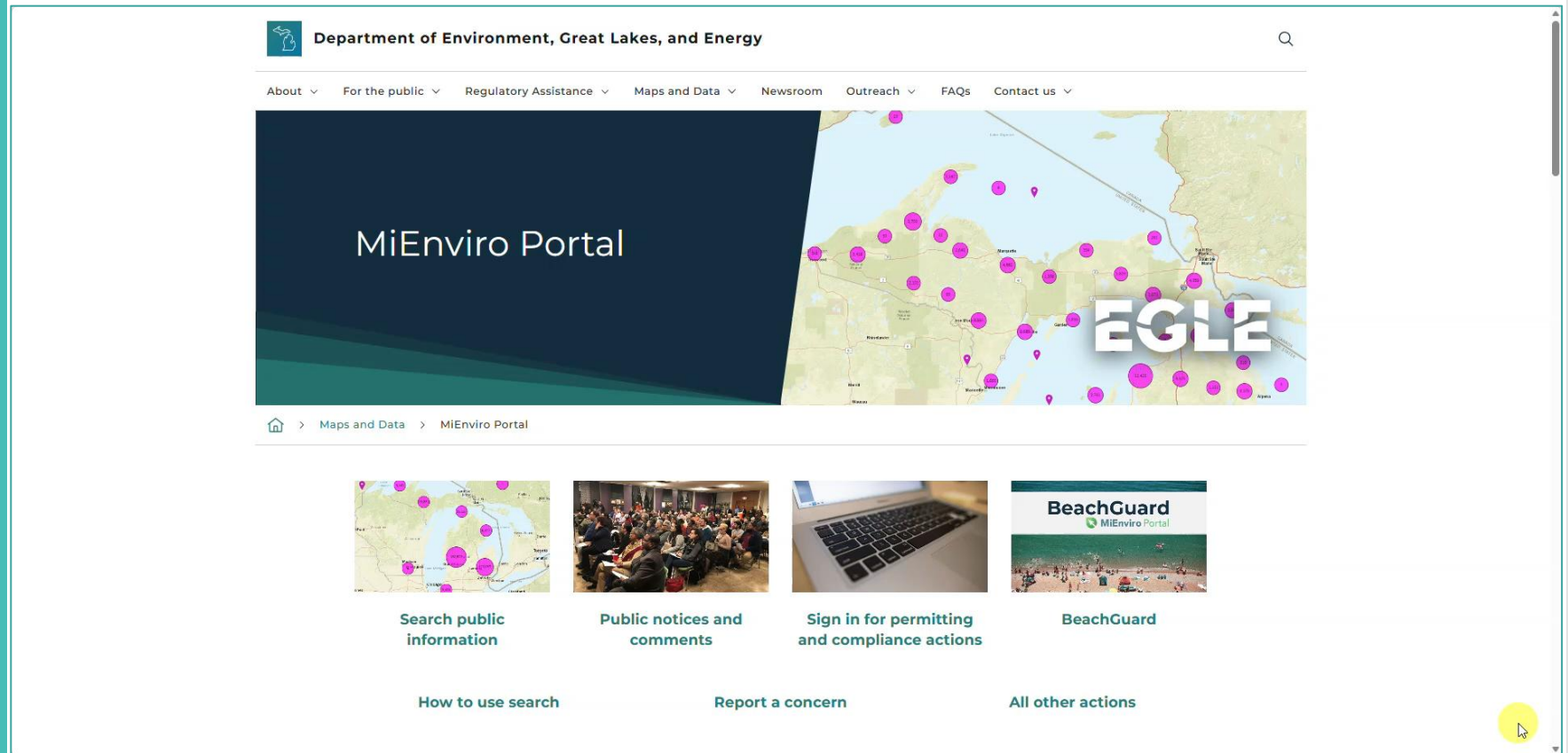

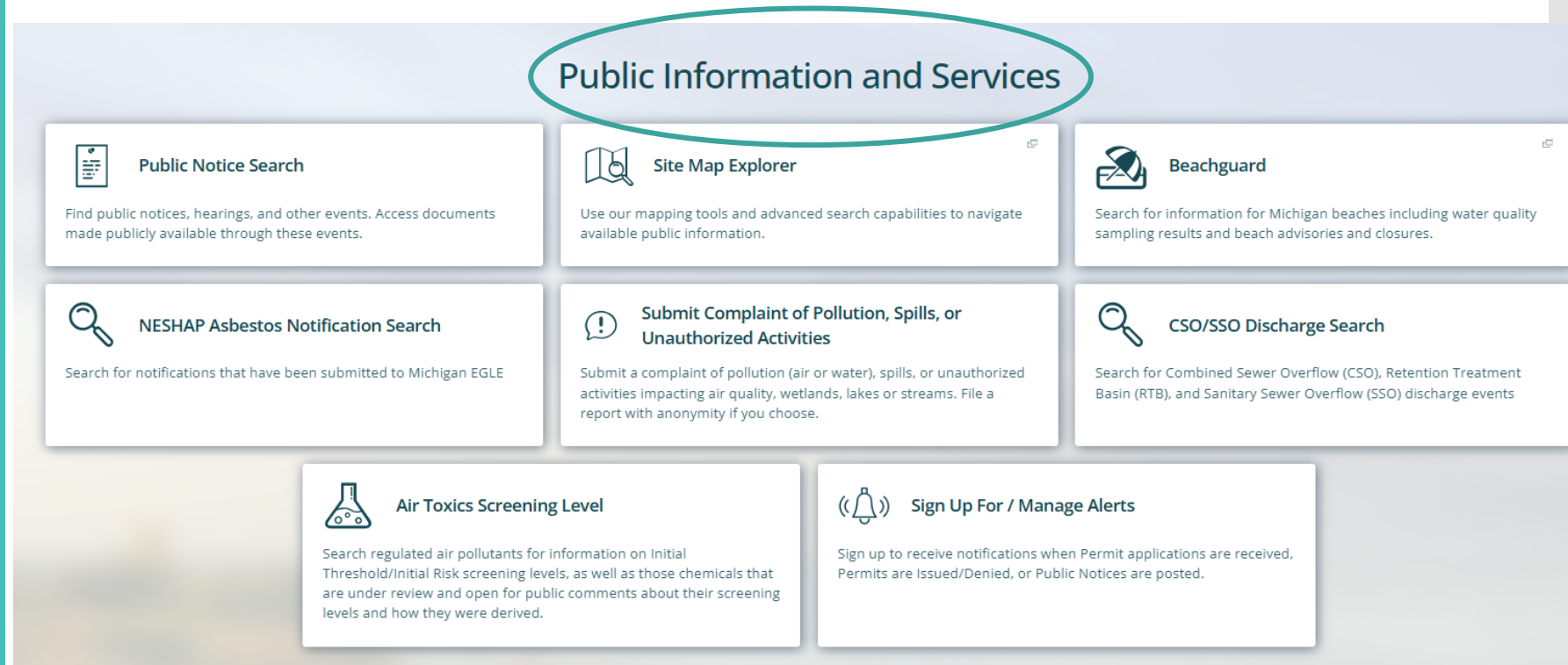

To find the site you are looking for, you can:

Use the Search Bar above

Enter any identifying information into the search bar above, and both the Results list and the map will populate with any relevant results. This is a general search and will return results for each word in the search bar.

OR

Manipulate the Map

Focus in on a specific location using a mouse and the zoom tools or click on a bubble and the map will zoom to the location.

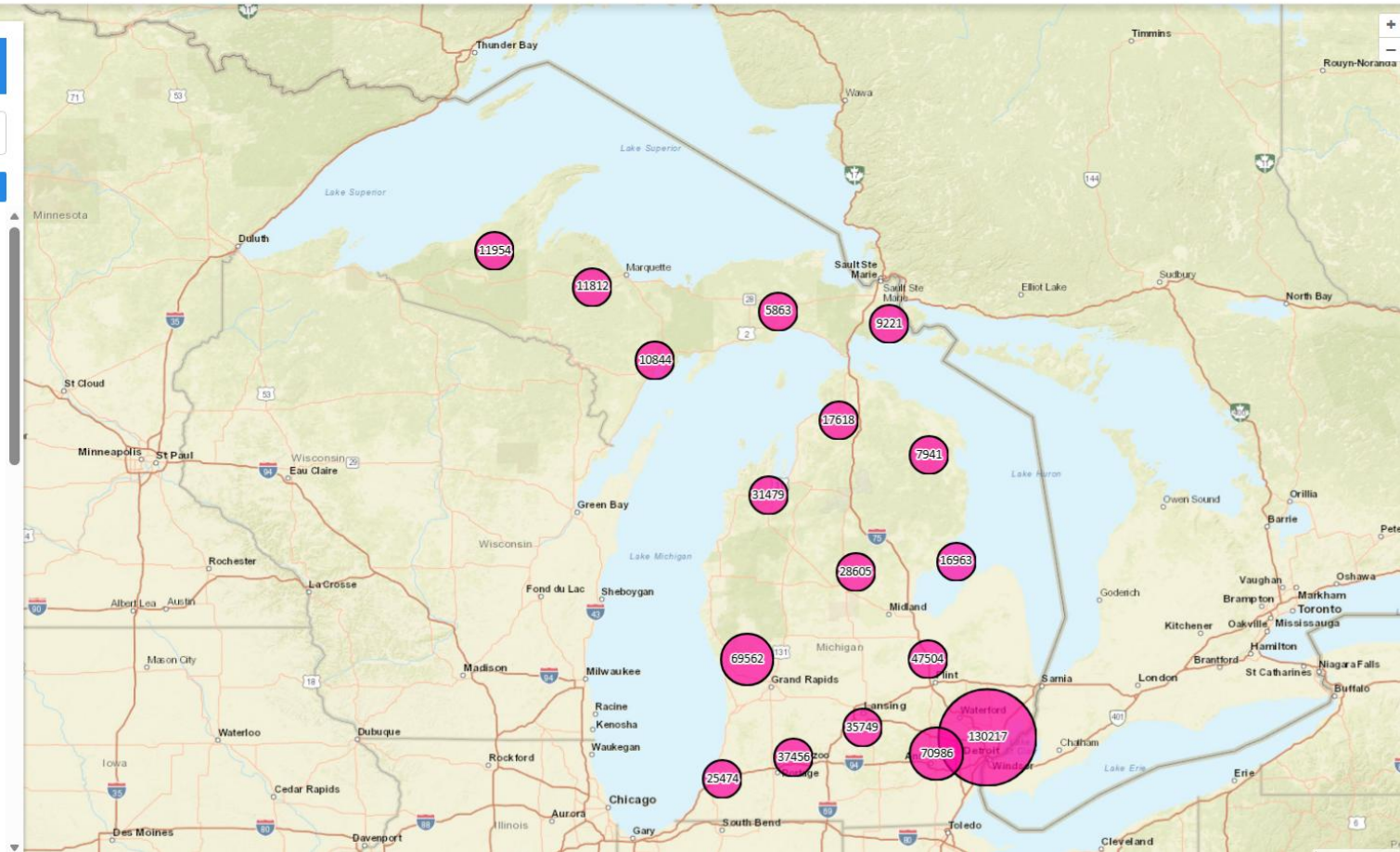
ADDITIONAL HELP

Simple Search

Enter any text into the keyword search. The results are based on each word. Using quotes does not create a phrase.

Filter

Items listed under the Filter tab limit your search results to the selected items. Filtering is applied in addition to the text you enter in the

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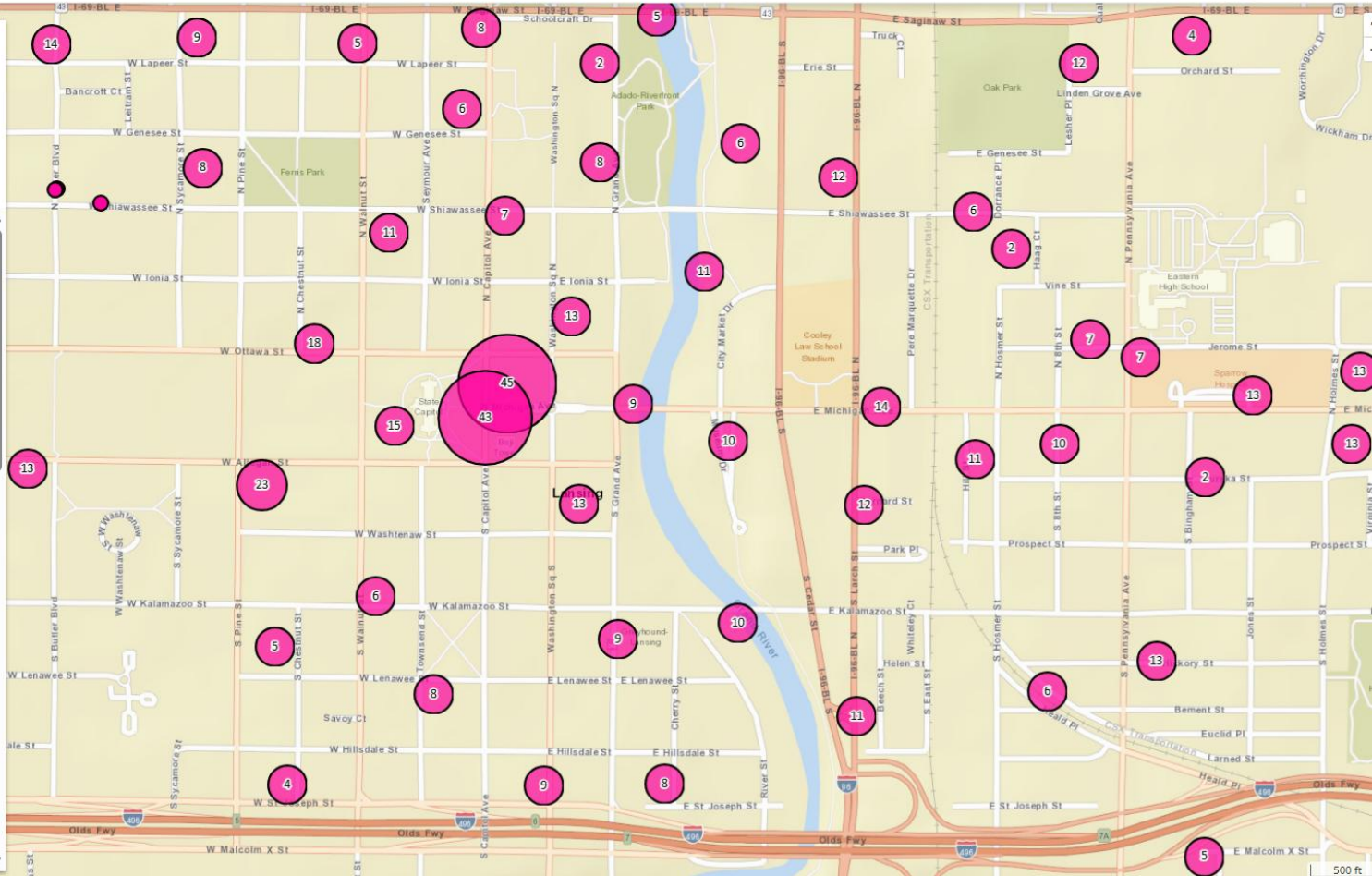

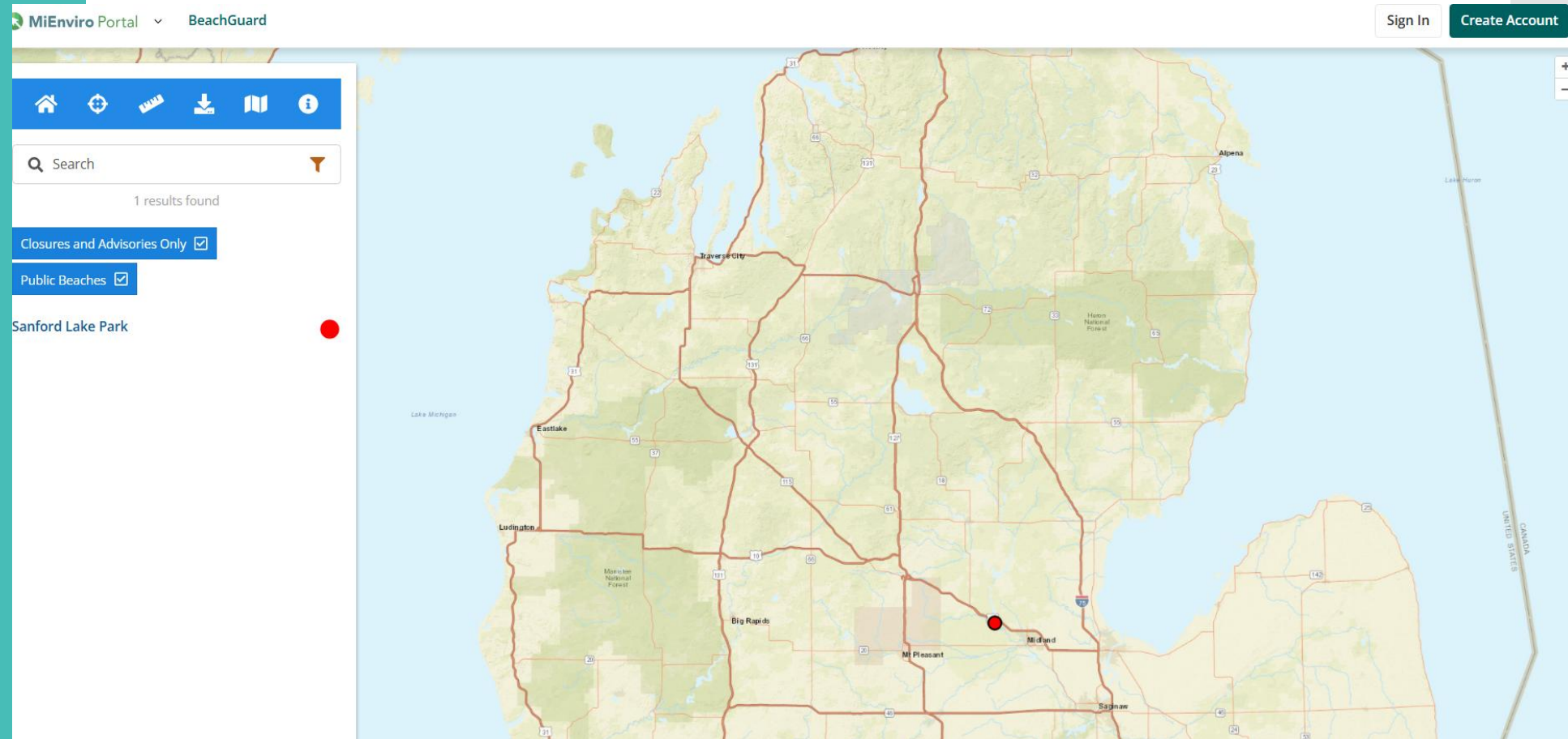


Beachguard

NESHAP Asbestos Notification Search

Search for notifications that have been submitted to Michigan EGLE

- Look up asbestos abatement and demolition projects
- Find details on an asbestos project
- See dates of when a demolition is occurring

What can I do here?



Submit Complaint of Pollution, Spills, or Unauthorized Activities

Submit a complaint of pollution (air or water), spills, or unauthorized activities impacting air quality, wetlands, lakes or streams. File a report with anonymity if you choose.

- Submit nonemergency complaints about pollution related to water or air
- Report unpermitted activity in wetlands, lakes, or streams
- Reports are sent directly to EGLE district offices

What can I do here?



CSO/SSO Discharge Search

Search for Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO), Retention Treatment Basin (RTB), and Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) discharge events

- Find information on releases of sewage from sewer systems
- Search by name, date, county, permit number, and more
- Learn how much was spilled and how it was cleaned up

What can I do here?



Air Toxics Screening Level

Search regulated air pollutants for information on Initial Threshold/Initial Risk screening levels, as well as those chemicals that are under review and open for public comments about their screening levels and how they were derived.

- Find information on air pollutants
- Look at screening levels
- Review justifications for screening levels
- Review chemicals that are open for public comment
- Comment on screening levels open for comment

What can I do here?



Sign Up For / Manage Alerts

Sign up to receive notifications when Permit applications are received, Permits are Issued/Denied, or Public Notices are posted.

- Sign up with your email to see what is happening in your neighborhood!
 - Permit applications submitted
 - Permit issuance
 - Permit denials
 - Public notices
 - Beach advisories and closures

You need an
account to:

- Apply for permits
- Manage your permits (pay fees, apply for renewals)
- View issued permits
- Submit reports (required by your permit or certification)
- Submit compliance notifications
- Submit service requests (such as Wetland Identification or Floodplain services)
- See your email notifications
- Review evaluations / site inspections
