

Matthieu Piel is a Physicist by training, with interest in multi-scale physics-chemistry-biology and cancer. He is a Group Leader at Institut Curie in Paris, France. His research team studies cell division, migration and mass/volume control, with a great focus in understanding how the mechanosensing relationship with cytoskeleton and organelles can influence these processes by using nano- and micro-fabrication tools. Besides being a Group Leader, Matthieu Piel is also a Professor of Cell Biology and Biophysics in several master courses in Paris. In 2012, he was awarded the Bronze medal of CNRS, in 2018 he was awarded the Grand Prix Jean Hamburger of research in medicine from the City of Paris, and he was elected as an EMBO member in 2016.
